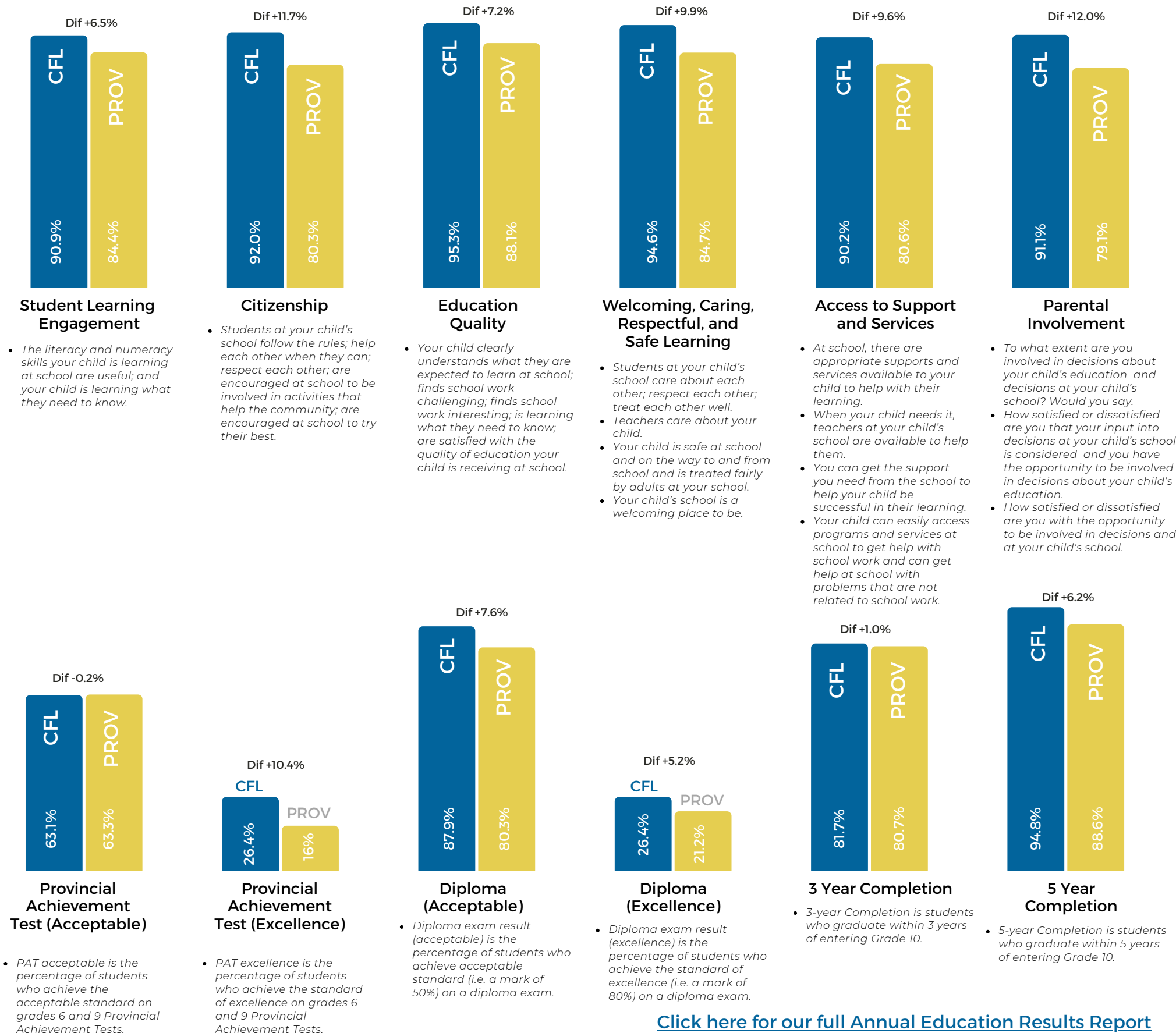


ALBERTA ASSURANCE ANNUAL EDUCATION RESULTS

Insights

- Diploma Excellence rate is very high and Acceptable rate is high. Teachers and students are re-adjusting to more rigorous programs. Teachers are focused on best practices to help our students achieve academic success. These results indicate CFL students are well prepared for post secondary programs, relative to their peers in the province.
- The Provincial Achievement Exam Acceptable rate more than doubled from the prior year and was on par with the provincial acceptable rate. The Provincial Achievement Test Excellence rate was 8% higher than the previous year, and also higher than the provincial rate. CFL's move to using Quest A+ to administer these exams significantly increased the school's participation rate, leading to a much higher acceptable rate than the previous year. It is anticipated that the participation rate will continue to increase again next year.
- Parental Involvement rate is significantly higher than the provincial rate. This speaks to our commitment to parents being the primary educators of their children and affirms The Centre for Learning@HOME as an excellent choice for parents seeking an alternative education option for their child.

Faith Survey Results

- 94%** Percentage of students, parents, and teachers who indicate that they are satisfied with the relationship that exists between the school and the local Catholic parish
- 93%** Percentage of students, parents and teachers who are satisfied with how they have grown as a Christian as a result of their involvement in Catholic Education
- 97%** Percentage of students, parents and teachers who are satisfied with what is being taught in religion classes
- 95%** Percentage of students, parents and teachers who indicate they are satisfied with the religious celebrations that are held at the school
